## NMSA407 – Linear Regression Exercise class: Final test

Academic year 2021/2022

The final test for all groups of exercise sessions takes place on

Thursday, December 16, 2021.

This document describes the overall organization of the test:

- The final test consists of 3 tasks. It is possible to gain 100 points in total. To successfully pass the test, at least 60 points need to be obtained. The extra points gained or lost for homework assignments will be counted towards the final result of the test. This includes the potentially obtained positive or negative points for the final solution of Homework 2.
- The test takes 90 minutes in total. Only paper and pen is allowed no calculators or mobile phones, and no printed materials or handwritten notes can be used.
- The final test can be taken in one of the three groups, each on Thursday, December 16:
  - $(G_1)$  15:40–17:10 in K4 (group ex. sessions Thursday, 15:40),
  - $(G_2)$  17:20–18:50 in K11 (group ex. sessions Thursday, 17:20), and
  - $(G_3)$  17:20–18:50 in K4 (group ex. sessions Tuesday, 17:20).

Students are expected to take the test in that group for which they are assigned to. Individual changes are possible, but must be discussed at least one week in advance with the teaching assistants.

- In the exceptional case if the health regulations do not allow the organization of an in-class test, a Zoom on-line test will take place instead. In that situation, details will be announced when appropriate.
- There will be **exactly one** additional term for the final test in January. Any student who could not attend the primary test (for whatsoever reason) or failed the primary test is eligible to attend the secondary test. Additional details about the secondary test will be provided at the end of December 2021. Depending on the current health regulations, the test may be held either physically in a classroom in the week 3–7.1.2022, or on-line at a date specified at least 2 weeks before the test. The extra (positive or negative) points for homeworks also count toward the retake of the final test.
