## Problem

$X^* \setminus NA(X)$  spaceable. Is  $X$  non-reflexive?

$X$  Banach. RNP  $\Leftrightarrow$  KMP ?

## Problem [Godefroy]

$X$  Banach.  $X \text{ KK}^*$ . Is it true that  $X$  is Asplund?

Does the long James space  $J(\Gamma)$  has  $(K^*)$ ?

$X$  separable,  $l_1 \not\hookrightarrow X$ , is  $X^*$   $\langle LUR \rangle$ ?

## Problem [Borwein–Fabian' 93]




Prove for all  $X$ ,  $\exists f : X \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$  convex continuous somewhere  
Gâteaux non Fréchet without Josefson–Nissenzweig.



## Problem

$X$  separable such that  $\|\cdot\|$  restricted to any closed subspace is somewhere Fréchet. Is  $X$  Asplund?

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
